CALIFORNIA WEBSITE PRIVACY NOTICE

The purpose of this California Website Privacy Notice (“**Privacy Notice**”) is to describe how AltaMed Health Services Corporation (“**AHS**,” “**we**,” or “**us**”) collects, uses, and discloses personal information from California residents, in compliance with the California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended (the “**CCPA**”) as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (“**CPRA**”).

I. Scope of This Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice applies only to California residents and addresses information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with California residents (“**Personal Information**”). This Notice does not apply to publicly available, aggregated, or de-identified information, nor to Protected Health Information (“**PHI**”) regulated under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (“**HIPAA**”). Please refer to our [HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices](#) for information about our PHI-related disclosures.

This Privacy Notice applies only to information governed by the CCPA. This Privacy Notice also does not cover Personal Information that may be collected about you as a job applicant or employee. Please visit our California Job Applicant Notice or our California Employee Notice for more information if you interacted with us in either of these capacities.

This Privacy Notice should be read in conjunction with our [Terms of Use](#) and any other document or agreement that governs your relationship with us. A link to this Privacy Notice is also available at the bottom of our website homepage, labeled ‘Your California Privacy Choices.’ By using our website, mobile application, products, and services (collectively, “**Services**”), you consent to our Terms of Use and the privacy practices disclosed in this Privacy Notice. If you do not consent to the practices described in this Privacy Notice, you may limit your use of certain features or manage your preferences via our Cookie Settings.

Unless otherwise noted, the disclosures herein cover our activities in the twelve (12) months preceding the Effective Date, as well as our current practices.

II. How and Why We Collect, Use, and Disclose Your Personal Information

AHS may collect, use, and disclose Personal Information for valid purposes consistent with applicable laws as identified below. Where we transfer applicable Personal Information to recipients, such as our service providers, we do so for the same business purposes described below. III. Sensitive Personal Information

We may collect limited Sensitive Personal Information (e.g., geolocation data or demographic information) solely for purposes permitted under California law. We do not use Sensitive Personal Information to infer characteristics or for profiling, and we do not process such data in a way that would trigger the right to limit under California law. We do not use or disclose Sensitive Personal Information for purposes to which the right to limit use and disclosure applies under the CCPA. Reproductive health and SUD treatment data are protected under federal regulations, requiring explicit consent for sharing or disclosure. While we may collect certain data such as precise geolocation or protected classification characteristics, we do not use or disclose this information to infer characteristics about you or for any purpose subject to the right to limit under the CCPA. We apply all required notices, use restrictions, and opt-out rights for sensitive personal information, including any newly designated categories under future CPPA regulations.

IV. Purpose of Collecting Personal Information

We collect and use Personal Information for the following purposes:

- To provide services: Enable account creation, facilitate transactions, and manage your relationship with us.
- For marketing: Send promotional materials, personalize content, and improve marketing campaigns.
- To enhance functionality: Improve website performance, conduct analytics, and debug technical issues.
- To comply with legal obligations: Meet regulatory requirements, prevent fraud, and ensure security.
- For employment purposes: Process job applications (if applicable).

V. Disclosing Your Personal Information

We may disclose each of the categories of Personal Information identified above to the respectively identified categories of recipients for operational or business purposes consistent with the purposes for collection or use designated, as is reasonably necessary and proportionate to achieve those purposes, or for another purpose that is compatible with the context in which the Personal Information was collected including, but not limited to:

- Auditing related to ads;
- Helping to ensure security and integrity;
- Debugging, repairing, and improving functionality;
- Short-term, transient use;
- Performing services on our behalf;
- Providing advertising and marketing services, as applicable;
- Internal research for technological development; and
- Verifying quality and/or safety.

In addition to the other purposes for collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information and described in this Privacy Notice, we may collect, use, and disclose Personal Information as required by law, regulation or court order; to respond to governmental and/or law enforcement requests; to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interfering with our or others' rights or property; to support any actual or threatened claim, defense or declaration in a threatened or pending case or before any jurisdictional and/or administrative authority, arbitration or mediation panel; or in connection with disciplinary actions/investigations. Likewise, we may disclose Personal Information to other parties in connection with the sale, assignment, merger, or reorganization.

We enter into contracts with our service providers and contractors that limit their use of Personal Information to specified business purposes and require them to provide at least the same level of privacy protection required under the CCPA. We may use or disclose de-identified data derived from personal information in a manner that does not identify individuals and is subject to appropriate safeguards, in accordance with the CCPA and CPPA regulations.

VI. Sources of Personal Information

We may collect Personal Information from the following sources:

- **Directly from you:** Information you provide through forms, applications, or communication. For example, when you sign up to receive information from us, or any other time you submit Personal Information to us voluntarily.
- **Automatically when you use our website or mobile apps:** Data collected through cookies, analytics tools, and similar technologies. For example, we may collect your usage history when you use our websites, systems, and applications.
- **Third Parties:** Service providers, advertising networks, and affiliates. We receive Personal Information from AHS affiliates, as permitted, to enable us to manage our business. We may also receive Personal Information from service providers who provide us with IT services, advertising services, or help facilitate our sales.
- **Parties to corporate transactions:** As permitted by law, we may receive Personal Information as part of a corporate transaction or proceeding such as a merger, financing, acquisition, bankruptcy, dissolution, or at transfer, divestiture, or sale of all or a portion of a business or assets.
- **Publicly Available Sources:** Information from public records or social media (if applicable).

VII. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We may use tracking technologies, such as cookies, including tracking technologies managed by vendors or external parties to improve functionality, analyze usage, and personalize content.

Tracking technologies can generally be categorized as follows:

- **Necessary or essential.** These tracking technologies are used for core functionality, for example for security and to enforce your privacy preferences. Without these cookies, some functionality on our websites and apps may fail.
- **Functional or analytics.** These tracking technologies help to improve our websites and apps by allowing us to understand how they are used and how they perform. We may also use location-aware technologies for purposes such as verifying your location and delivering or restricting content based on your location.
- **Advertising.** These tracking technologies help personalize ads that are shown to you on our websites and apps. If enabled, these tracking technologies will allow other parties to engage in advertising based on your use of online services

We may use Google Analytics or other providers for analytics services. We may also implement Google Analytics Advertising Features such as remarketing with analytics and interest-based ads. We may use first-party cookies or other first-party identifiers as well as third-party cookies or other third-party identifiers to, e.g., deliver advertisements, measure your interests, and/or personalize content. Depending on your device settings, you may also opt out of certain interest-based advertising through the device's "Limit Ad Tracking" or equivalent feature. Refer to your device for more information on what this opt out affects. For instance, you can adjust or reset the advertising

identifiers on your mobile device in the device settings. iOS users can visit Settings > Privacy > Advertising > Reset Advertising Identifier. Android users can visit Google settings > Ads > Reset advertising ID.

VIII. How Long We Keep Your Personal Information

We retain Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Notice, comply with legal obligations, and resolve disputes. Retention periods vary by data type and legal requirements.

Retention periods are determined based on the specific use case for each category of Personal Information. We retain information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which it was collected, including to satisfy legal or regulatory obligations, support our operational or analytical needs, or maintain your relationship with us. Where data serves multiple purposes, we retain it until the latest applicable purpose expires.

We keep the categories of Personal Information described above for as long as is necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice or otherwise authorized by law. This generally means holding the information for as long as one of the following apply:

- Your Personal Information is reasonably necessary to manage our operations, to manage your relationship with us, or to satisfy another purpose for which we collected the information;
- Your Personal Information is reasonably necessary to carry out a disclosed purpose that is reasonably compatible with the context in which the Personal Information was collected;
- The information is reasonably required to protect or defend our rights or property (which will generally relate to applicable laws that limit actions in a particular case); or
- We are otherwise required or permitted to keep your information by applicable laws or regulations.

Where information is used for more than one purpose, we will retain it until the purpose with the latest period expires. For more information about our retention policies, please contact us using the contact details below.

IX. Sharing and Selling Personal Information

We may sell or share the following categories of Personal Information with third parties for the purposes of cross-context behavioral advertising:

- Identifiers
- Internet or other electronic network activity
- Geolocation data

We may sell and/or share this Personal Information with third parties for advertising purposes. The third parties to whom this Personal Information was sold and/or shared are advertisers and analytics vendors.

We may also share your Personal Information with regulatory authorities to comply with legal requirements.

We offer you the ability to opt out of sales and sharing of your Personal Information as set forth in the “Right to Opt Out of Sales and Sharing of Personal Information” section below.

We do not knowingly sell or share the Personal Information of consumers under the age of sixteen (16).

X. Consumer Rights Under the CCPA/CPRA

If you are a California resident, you are entitled to certain rights. Please note that if you submit a request to know, request to delete, or request to correct, you may be asked to provide two-to-three (2-3) pieces of Personal Information that we

will match against our records to verify your identity. You may designate an authorized agent to make a request on your behalf. However, you will still need to verify your identity directly with us before your request can be processed.

Right to Know. You have the right to know what Personal Information we have collected about you, which includes:

1. The categories of Personal Information we have collected about you, including:
 - a. The categories of Personal Information we collect, use, and disclose;
 - b. The sources of the Personal Information that was collected;
 - c. Our business or commercial purposes for collecting, selling, or sharing Personal Information;
 - d. The categories of recipients to which we disclose Personal Information;
 - e. The categories of Personal Information that we sold, and for each category identified, the categories of third parties to which we sold that particular category of Personal Information
 - f. The categories of Personal Information that we disclosed for a business purpose, and for each category identified, the categories of recipients to which we disclosed that particular category of Personal Information.
2. The specific pieces of Personal Information we have collected about you.

Right to Delete Your Personal Information. You have the right to request that we delete Personal Information we collected from you, subject to certain exceptions.

Right to Correct Inaccurate Information. If you believe that Personal Information we maintain about you is inaccurate, you have the right to request that we correct that information.

Right to Opt-Out of Sales and Sharing of Personal Information. You have the right to opt out of the sale of your Personal Information, and to request that we do not share your Personal Information for cross-context behavioral advertising. To opt-out, please review our [Cookie Settings](#). Our Cookie Settings link is available on our website and enables you to opt out of the sale or sharing of your Personal Information through cookies or similar tracking technologies. Some cookies and tracking technologies used on our site may be considered a 'sale' or 'sharing' of personal information under California law. Where applicable, we contract with third-party vendors to limit their use of personal information as service providers.

The [Global Privacy Control](#) ("GPC") is a browser-based signal that communicates your privacy preferences to websites. We treat GPC signals as valid opt-out requests for online sales and sharing where required by law. If you choose to use the GPC browser signal, you will only be opted out of online sales or sharing of Personal Information, and will need to turn it on for each browser you use.

Please note that opt-out mechanisms for online tracking (such as Cookie Settings or Global Privacy Control signals) apply only to browser-based or device-based activity.

To submit a request to opt out of offline sales and sharing which would not otherwise be controlled by GPC, please contact us as provided below. To opt out of offline sales or sharing (e.g., via paper forms or call centers), please submit a request through our Data Subject Access Request Form or call us toll-free at (888) 418-1398.

Right to Limit Use and Disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information. We do not use or disclose sensitive Personal Information for purposes to which the right to limit use and disclosure applies under the CCPA.

Right to Non-Discrimination for the Exercise of Your Privacy Rights. If you choose to exercise any of your privacy rights under the CCPA, you also have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment by us.

We do not currently engage in profiling or make significant decisions based solely on automated decision-making technology ('ADMT'), as defined under California law. If we implement such practices in the future, we will update this Privacy Notice accordingly and provide required disclosures, including consumer opt-out or access rights, consistent with CPPA regulations.

XI. Notice of Financial Incentive

AHS does not run any financial incentive programs. Financial Incentive Programs include "payments to consumers as compensation, for the collection of personal information, the sale or sharing of personal information, or the retention of personal information. A business may also offer a different price, rate, level, or quality of goods or services to the consumer if that price or difference is reasonably related to the value provided to the business by the consumer's data."

XII. Security Measures

We use appropriate administrative, technical, physical, and organizational safeguards to protect the Personal Information we collect and process about you. The measures we use are designed to provide a level of security appropriate to the risk of processing your Personal Information. This includes managerial measures, including establishment and implementation of internal management plan and periodic training for employees; technical measures, including controlling access rights to personal information processing systems and encryption of important data; and physical measures, including external security and management of system servers. While we implement security measures designed to be appropriate to the relevant risks, please note no data transmission over the internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed as being 100% secure. Use our services at your own risk.

We conduct periodic privacy risk assessments as required by California law, including under current or future regulations adopted by the California Privacy Protection Agency. These assessments evaluate our data processing activities, particularly those involving sensitive personal information, high-risk automated decision-making, or cross-context behavioral advertising. While not submitted to regulators, such assessments are available upon lawful request by regulatory authorities

XIII. California "Shine the Light"
